## <u>Impact statement of Pupil Premium 2018-19</u>

- 1. The school attainment in phonics was 100% therefore the smaller streamed groups have been successful and will continue into the next academic year.
- 2. The school have invested in Accelerated Reader to encourage more focused reading from Year 2 to Year 6. Guided reading and 1-1 reading is now regularly seen throughout the school. Bedtime reading scheme is now embedded throughout KS1.
- 3. Targeted intervention boosters are in place for Year 6 children and an extra teacher to support the children in Maths and English.
- 4. Staff have engaged in CPD for both Maths and English to enhance the teaching sequence ensuring well planned lessons are delivered and pupil premium children are successful through appropriate scaffolding and stretching.
- 5. A variety of extra curricular activities are now provided for Pupil Premium children to engage in. Breakfast club is free for Pupil Premium children. Some music and sporting events are subsided to ensure full participation of all pupil premium children.
- 6. Pupil premium children attendance has increased slightly.
- 7. A member of staff has been employed to work with SEMH and Pupil Premium children delivering 1-1 mentoring, nurture and friendship groups and developing a role in parental liaison.
