Afterschool clubs

Just a reminder that all after school clubs will NOT take place during the first week back and will resume, with additional clubs, week beginning 7th November, 2022. Wrap around provision will continue as usual.

Attendance

The law entitles every child of compulsory school age to an efficient, full-time education. It is the legal responsibility of every parent to make sure their child receives that education either by attendance at a school or by education otherwise than at a school. Where parents decide to have their child registered at school, they have an additional legal duty to ensure their child attends that school regularly. This means their child must attend every day that the school is open, except in a small number of allowable circumstances such as being too ill to attend or being given permission for an absence in advance from the school. St Leonard's has a legal obligation to monitor attendance and punctuality and challenge this, where relevant. This is especially the case where attendance falls below 90%, as this can have a significant impact on your child's education. Where attendance continues to be very low, we will contact parents to discuss how we can work together to address this. If no improvement is seen, we will act in line with our policy and that of the local authority. Please help us to ensure your child gets the best opportunities possible and attends school. Our goal is always 100% attendance for every child!
