### Winter weather and uniform.

As the weather turns increasingly cold, I want to remind parents of the importance of children wearing the correct outdoor clothing. Please ensure your child has a warm coat, hat and gloves – as outdoor playtimes will continue except in the most extreme weather situations. Also, please consider the footwear your child wears. If children are wearing boots or wellies to school, please make sure they bring black, indoor shoes to change into.

Under no circumstances should children wear any jewellery or make up (including nail varnish) to school. Where breaches to school uniform are seen, parents will be contacted.
